Capacity Building and Growth






Current Share of Target Market (Districts)

What is the Course Management Portal?

The Course Management Portal (CMP) allows California schools to verify if their coursework meets "a-g" subject area requirements.

The CMP is:

- Managed by University of California Office of the President (UCOP).
- The "source of truth" used by CSUs and UCs to determine a student's eligibility for admission.








What is "a-g" Misalignment?

"a-g" misalignment occurs when the way a course is listed in a district's SIS doesn't align with the way it is listed in the Course Management Portal (CMP).





What "a-g" Misalignment Looks Like

Impact of Misaligned Courses

CaliforniaColleges.edu provides real-time data that helps inform educators' decisions about student coursework, guidance, and support.

This helps ensure that more students are able to successfully transition from high school to higher education.

Alignment with CMP helps minimize:









Why Transcripts Matter

High School Transcript Data is integral to the following processes:

- Admission Application
- → Final Admissions Clearance
- → First Year Academic Placement
- > Financial Aid (Cal Grant GPA and confirmation of graduation)
- → Transfer Eligibility
- → Prerequisite clearance for particular majors and pathways (especially STEM)



High School Transcript and Student Record Portability Standard

For the first time, California will have a published standard for how high school transcript data should be handled.

- Specific to electronic transmission
- Facilitates alignment
- Under review with CDE, CCCCO, CSUCO, UCOP and CSAC
 - ◆ Comment period until December 15, 2023
 - Endorsement requested by January 30, 2024
- Will be housed at C2C and managed by CCGI
- Will be versioned to maintain alignment with student and institutional needs




How Do We Get To Scale?

In order to scale, we will build out API Integrations with Student Information System (SIS) providers.

- Reduces barriers to entry for districts with minimal data capacity
- Reduces workload on existing partner districts
- Enables CCGI to serve more district without increased FTE




K-12 Market Share by SIS Provider
