

## CCGI Final Data Summary

In late June/early July of 2022, California College Guidance Initiative (CCGI) began providing Liaison with an updated high school coursework file containing final grades for applicants who imported high school coursework data from CCGI into the Cal State Apply application. The final coursework data from CCGI inserts grades for courses previously listed as “Planned” and/or “In Progress” and is considered transcript-level data that updates the High School Coursework Report and Hight School Coursework A-G Report available in WebAdmit. CCGI will provide the final coursework data to Liaison annually. ## WebAdmit Applicant List to Export CCGI Final Data

Campuses need to create a new Applicant List in WebAdmit to specifically export the applicants that have the CCGI final data. Campuses do not need to re-export the entire applicant population who previously provided high school coursework on the Cal State Apply application. Liaison recommends using the new “Update High School Name” field to search for applicants with the CCGI final data. The new field can be found in the new *Updated Secondary (High) School* category.

The following are steps to create an Applicant List to select applicants with CCGI final data:

1. Log into WebAdmit.
2. Under the *Applicant Lists*, click the option **List Manager**.
3. Click the **New Field List** button.
4. Enter a name for the applicant list.
5. Select the work group(s) that should have access to this applicant list.
6. In the **Click to Select Field** dropdown, select *Updated Secondary (High) School* category.
7. In the *Updated Secondary (High) School* category, select the field *Updated High School Name* and select the search operator *is not null*.
