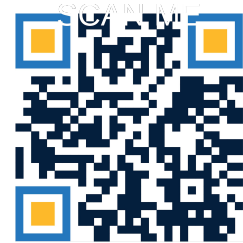

The State of California's Official College and Career Planning Platform

More than 80% of California's 1.9 million high school students are enrolled in a school district that has already partnered with CCGI.

- Our Partner Districts include more than **450 LEAs** that serve more than **1.5 million students** in grades 9-12.
 - More than **1.1 million high school students** have **transcript data live** on the platform to power eligibility tools and application integrations.
- California Education Code 60900(f)(3) now requires that all LEAs that enroll 9-12 grade students enter into a data sharing agreement with CCGI by **January 2026**.

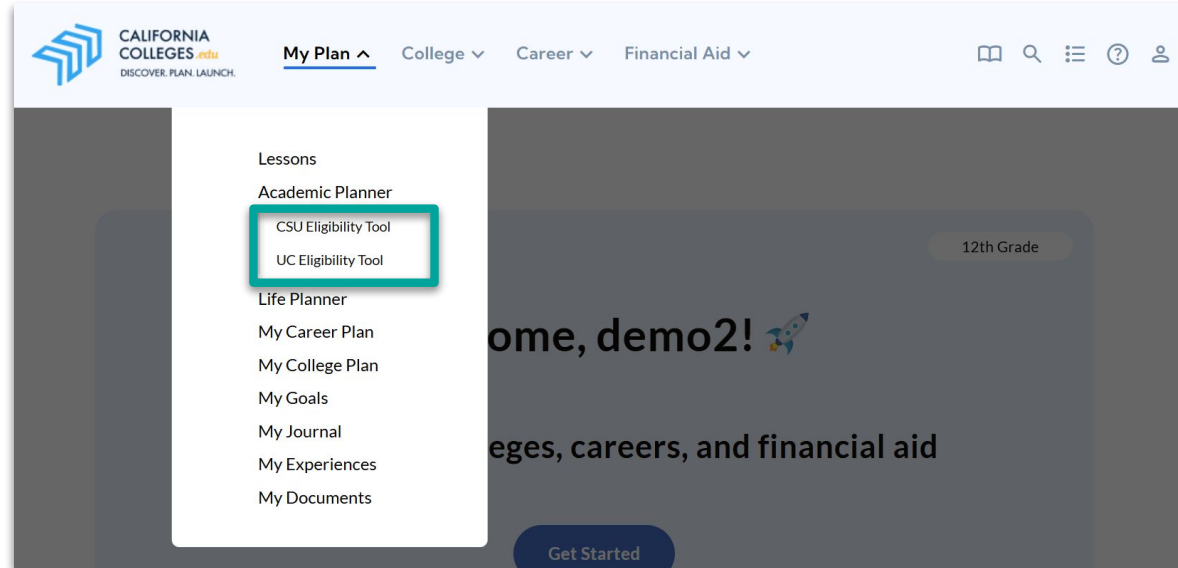


Transcript-Informed Tools





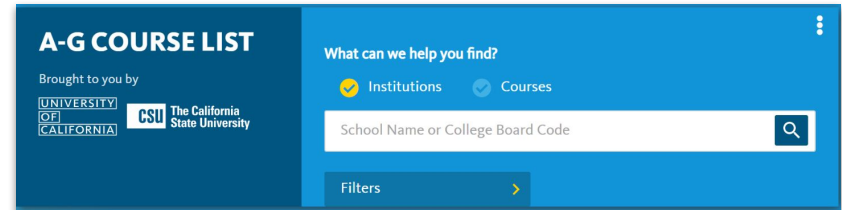

The Course Management Portal (CMP) is where all California districts and/or their schools manage their public-facing “A-G Course List.”

- The approved course list from the CMP is what determines which California high school coursework fulfills an A-G subject area for the purpose of CSU and UC admission processes.
- CaliforniaColleges.edu uses the official CMP course list for each school to **verify the transcript data** shared by districts.
- Verification of data provided from the district’s SIS against the CMP informs how coursework visualizes for students in the CSU and UC eligibility tools.



- Some schools may also see Yellow course tags that indicate “Out of State,” “Out of Country” and “College Credit” coursework.
 - Since not all schools/SIS systems have the data elements necessary to surface these elements yet, you may see these types of courses showing with the “Unknown Schools” tag instead.

What About Dual Enrollment?

Dual Enrollment (DE) is a method that students can use to meet A-G requirements, but college courses cannot be verified using high school transcript data.

- “California high schools should not add California community college courses to their UC approved A-G course lists, even though instruction may happen on a high school campus with a high school instructor”

- College courses must be entered into the College sections of the CSU and UC applications, which are programmed to recognize one semester of College coursework as fulfilling a full year of A-G.

Using available funding apportioned to the community college district pursuant to Section 84750.4, the governing board of the community college district shall report the pupil's completed courses and grades received through eTranscript California, also referred to as "eTranscriptCA," for purposes of enabling the uniform integration of the pupil's completed courses and grades received into the pupil's universal and electronic high school transcript that is housed on the **CaliforniaColleges.edu** platform.

Formal guidance from the UC & CSU

EDC § 66205.5

The California State University shall, and the University of California is requested to, do all of the following:

(a) Establish a model uniform set of academic standards for high school courses and college-level coursework taken for credit at a California public college or university by pupils simultaneously enrolled in high school...

(b) It is the intent of the Legislature that the model academic standards provide clarity as to their applicability to a given course to ensure suitability for electronic transmission of coursework to and between California's public education systems and **CaliforniaColleges.edu**.

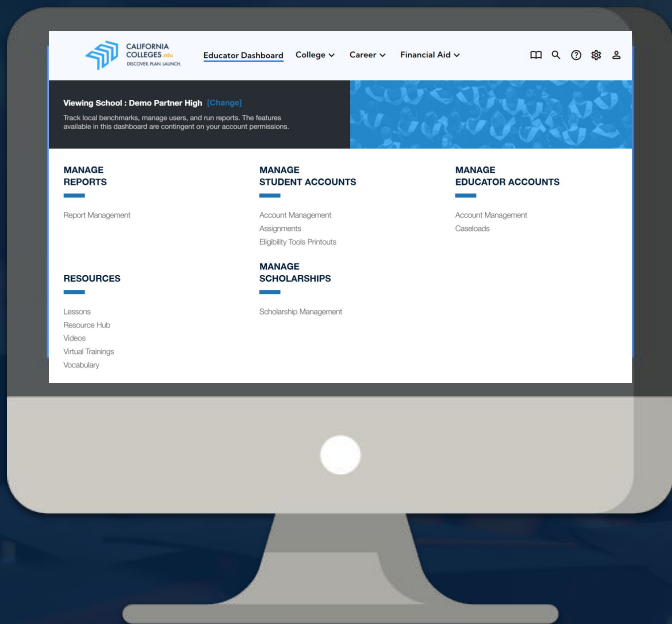

(c) Using available funding apportioned to their community college district pursuant to Section 84750.4, community colleges enrolling high school pupils through dual or concurrent enrollment pursuant to Sections 48800 and 76001, shall use eTranscript California, also referred to as "eTranscriptCA," or its successor system, to enable the uniform integration of the pupil's completed courses and grades received into the pupil's universal and electronic high school transcript that is housed on the **CaliforniaColleges.edu** platform.
