

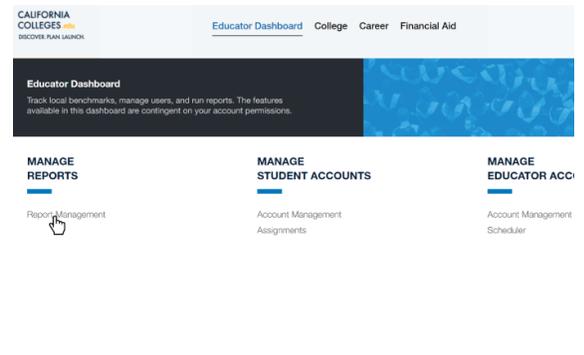


## Confirming Student Account Registration

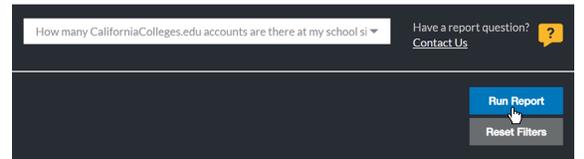
CaliforniaColleges.edu gives your students access to a wide range of tools that can help them discover their college and career goals, make plans for how to achieve them, and launch into fulfilling futures. But before they can take advantage of these tools, students must first register their accounts.

The account registration reporting tool on CaliforniaColleges.edu allows you to quickly identify which students have yet to register, so you can follow up and ensure they have access to their accounts.

- To access the tool, sign in to your CaliforniaColleges.edu account, and, from the Educator Dashboard, click **Report Management**.
- Select the report category **Accounts**, and click on **How many CaliforniaColleges.edu accounts are there at my school site?** Then click **Run Report**.
- This report tells you at a glance how many CaliforniaColleges.edu accounts have been created for your school site and how many of those are registered.
- For each user role, you can see the number of accounts that are registered, the number that are unregistered, the total number of accounts and the percentage of accounts that are registered.
- Those listed under the user roles **High School** or **Middle School** are student accounts.



After logging in, your dashboard will direct you to the reporting tool. Select a report to generate your filters, and individual links with the summary for more details. Drill down even further, if you choose, by clicking on individual links.

– Clicking on the number under **Unregistered Accounts** will take you to a list of all unregistered student accounts.

– Use the **Up** and **Down Arrow** icons to sort the list by Account Name and Grade.

– To download this information as a spreadsheet you can view on your computer, go to the **Actions** options and click **Download XLSX** or **Download CSV**. Clicking **Summary** will take you back to the Summary view.

– If a student is already registered, you can view more details by clicking on the number listed under **Registered Accounts**.

– This provides you with a list of all registered student accounts, including their name, grade, SSID, local ID, username, and the time of the student’s most recent sign-in to their account.

– Clicking on a student’s name will take you into their **My Plan**, where you can view their coursework and other college and career planning information.
