








Within the MTSS Framework

Tier 3 – Intensive Interventions

Efficiencies at Tier 1 and 2 free time for educators to provide 1:1 support.



Tier 2 - Targeted Interventions & Programming

- Use reports to target eligible students who have not started or completed applications during application windows
- ► Invite targeted students and/or families to application workshops
- Call in targeted students to provide application support in groups

Tier 1 - Universal Interventions

- Guide seniors to log in and teach them how to launch applications in classroom presentations
- Send tutorial instructions to all senior families via newsletter or communication platform








Step 2: Link Your Account




Select Confirm to be taken to Cal State Apply.

- Select Show Me How.





UC & CSU: Courses that WILL Import


CMP-verified courses appear in Green 🞧, Red 🕕, and Light Blue 🕒 (Enrolled or Planned)





UC & CSU: Courses that Will NOT Import

Courses that appear in Dark Gray were not indicated by the district as A-G coursework.






Courses that appear in **Dark Gray** will not import. No action is needed.



CSU & UC: Yellow Courses Require Action!

Courses appearing in <u>Yellow</u> ? were indicated by the district as an A-G course, but could not be matched against the CMP.





Yellow Course Action Steps

Application	Yellow Course Action Steps
CAL STATE APPLY	 Some Courses Will Import: Some will not import, and will require manual entry as applicable Some will import and require A-G matching Review all yellow courses and take actions to ensure they are entered properly.
OF CALIFORNIA	None of these courses will import. Add all yellow courses manually, as appropriate.



Finding the **CSU** and **UC Application Info Tabs**

- Navigate to the Academic Planner
- Click the CSU Application Info or **UC** Application Info tab














Academic Plan

Keep track of your completed classes, grades earned, and also plan for high school classes using your Academic Plan.



As a high school senior, you can launch Cal State Apply from California Colleges, edu and import your coursework and grades into the "High School Coursework" section of your CSU application.

NOTE: Importing courses doesn't replace the need to closely review all of your coursework and the A-G Matching page before you submit your application.

• Tip: On the A-G Matching page, always click "Update A-G Courses" under the A-G Subject Totals screen. This is where you'll make sure that every course included in your application is assigned to the right A-G subject area.

Add, Review and Edit Your Coursework

Add Missing Courses

Some courses can't be imported into Cal State Apply. You'll have to add these courses to your application. When you add a course, A-G matching will be required.

- Middle School Courses: If you took mathematics or foreign language courses in 7th and 8th grade to fulfill A-G requirements, you must add them to your application.
- o In the High School Coursework section, select the appropriate grade level (e.g. 7th grade, 8th grade), the high school you attended in 9th grade, and your 9th grade academic year.
- College Credit/Dual Enrollment: If you took college courses during high school, they must be reported in the College Coursework section of Cal State Apply. For most students, these courses aren't imported at all. For some students, they are imported into the High School Coursework section by mistake.
 - a If your college courses are missing from your application you must add them first report the College (a) Attended Then report all college courses you've taken in



The CaliforniaColleges.edu Course Import

What It Does	What it Does Not	
Saves time: Can <u>significantly reduce</u> the time required to complete CSU and UC applications	It does NOT replace the need to review all course records for accuracy prior to application submission	
Reduces errors: Verifies high school course records against the CMP and pre-populates that information to applications		
Supports intentional review: Allows counselors & college access staff to identify and focus time and energy on students records that are the most complex	It does NOT replace the need for counselors and/or college access staff to support students	



Courses That (Always) Require Close Review

- Middle School courses
- Dual Enrollment (college courses taken in high school)
- Courses completed outside of California
- Courses completed outside of the US
- Future/Planned Courses
- Summer School Courses
- Repeated Courses
- Credit Recovery with Variable Units







Opportunities for Tier 2 Support

Reporting features allow educators to take intentional action to support students in priority groups

Examples:

- Students have had not yet started any college application.
- Students who have started an application but have not yet completed it.
- UC eligible students who have not applied to UC or CSU
- CSU eligible students who have not yet applied to CSU


