

# CSU & UC Eligibility Tools (Students)

As a high school senior, you can [launch your UC Application from CaliforniaColleges.edu](#) and import your course and grade information into the "Academic History" section of your UC application.

**NOTE:** Importing courses doesn't replace the need to closely review all of your coursework before you submit your application.

- **Tip:** To import your coursework from CaliforniaColleges.edu, you must include your accurate **10-digit SSID number** in the "About You" section of the application. You must also **check the box** right below the SSID field to allow your UC application status to be shared with the California College Guidance Initiative (also known as CaliforniaColleges.edu).

## Add, Review and Edit Your Coursework

### Add Missing Courses

Yellow courses in your **UC Eligibility tab** will **ALWAYS** require action in the UC Application. Your school indicates they meet an A-G requirement, but that can't be verified. These courses will **not import** into your application. You will have to **add them manually**.

These types of courses on your transcript also require special attention:

- **Middle School Courses:** If you took mathematics or foreign language courses in 7th and 8th grade to fulfill A-G requirements, you must **add** them into the "7th & 8th grade" subsection of the Academic history section.
  - You should enter these courses *only* if you received a grade of C or better.



# Finding the CSU and UC Application Info Tabs

As a high school senior, you can launch Cal State Apply from CaliforniaColleges.edu and import your coursework and grades into the "High School Coursework" section of your CSU application.

**NOTE:** Importing courses doesn't replace the need to closely review all of your coursework and the A-G Matching page before you submit your application.

- **Tip:** On the A-G Matching page, always click "Update A-G Courses" under the A-G Subject Totals screen. This is where you'll make sure that *every course* included in your application is assigned to the right A-G subject area.

## Add, Review and Edit Your Coursework

### Add Missing Courses

Some courses can't be imported into Cal State Apply. You'll have to add these courses to your application. When you add a course, A-G matching will be required.

- **Middle School Courses:** If you took mathematics or foreign language courses in 7th and 8th grade to fulfill A-G requirements, you must **add** them to your application.
  - In the **High School Coursework** section, select the appropriate grade level (e.g. 7th grade, 8th grade), the high school you attended in 9th grade, and your 9th grade academic year.
- **College Credit/Dual Enrollment:** If you took college courses during high school, they must be reported in the **College Coursework** section of Cal State Apply. For most students, these courses aren't imported at all. For some students, they are imported into the High School Coursework section by mistake.
  - If your college courses are missing from your application, you must add them. First, report the College(s) Attended. Then, report all college courses you've taken in




# Review Imported Coursework

- ▶ **A close review of all application coursework (imported or entered) is important** to ensure that it is correct and complete.
- ▶ Students may need to add or edit courses and grades.
- ▶ All yellow courses require review and action.






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# Within the MTSS Framework

## Tier 3 – Intensive Interventions

Efficiencies at Tier 1 and 2 free time for educators to provide 1:1 support.



## Tier 2 – Targeted Interventions & Programming

- ▶ Use reports to target eligible students who have not started or completed applications during application windows
- ▶ Invite targeted students and/or families to application workshops
- ▶ Call in targeted students to provide application support in groups

## Tier 1 – Universal Interventions

- ▶ Guide seniors to log in and teach them how to launch applications in classroom presentations
- ▶ Send tutorial instructions to all senior families via newsletter or communication platform


