In Summer 2024, California Education Code 60900 was updated to require all California public local educational agencies serving 9th - 12th graders to enter into a data-sharing agreement with the California College Guidance Initiative by January 2026 to provide transcript-informed Partner Accounts on CaliforniaColleges.edu by June 2026.
