

Running CSU & UC Eligibility Reports

CSU GPA

You are currently meeting the minimum GPA requirement of 2.0 or above. Your CSU GPA reflects “a-g” coursework submitted by your school district completed in 10th, 11th, and 12th grades, including the summers following 9th, 10th, and 11th grades.

Courses that have UC Honors Approved under the title are approved as honors in the UC CMP database. Eligible courses receive an extra one point in the CSU GPA calculation.



Running Cal State Apply Application Reports



Running Financial Aid Application Reports

To ensure your students can access financial aid, you need to know which have submitted their applications and which might need more support. Launching FAFSA or California Dream Act applications via CaliforniaColleges.edu associates your students' SSIDs with their application launches, prevents students from being lured to predatory financial aid websites, and allows you to monitor the status of their financial aid applications.
