Phase I: Onboarding

Before a partner district can implement CaliforniaColleges.edu, it must go through a 3-step onboarding process. Those steps are:

1. Pre-MOU	2. Contracting	3. Data Testing & "Go Live"
		• MOLL is fully executed

- LEA submits Application for Technical Assistance.
- LEA registers for and attends a Launch Meeting.
- CCGI sends LEA an MOU.
- LEA completes parent/ guardian notification process and captures opt-outs in SIS.
- MOU is fully executed.
- Parent Opt-Out deadline passed.
- LEA undergoes transcript testing.
- "Go Live" date is established.
