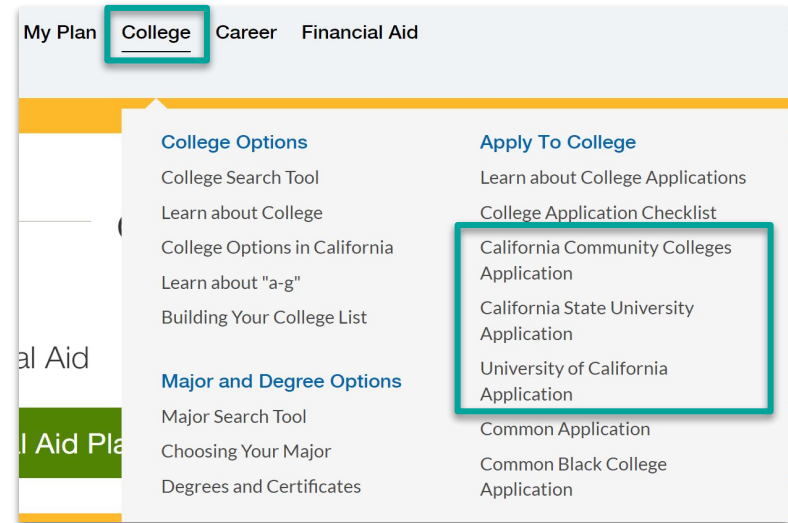

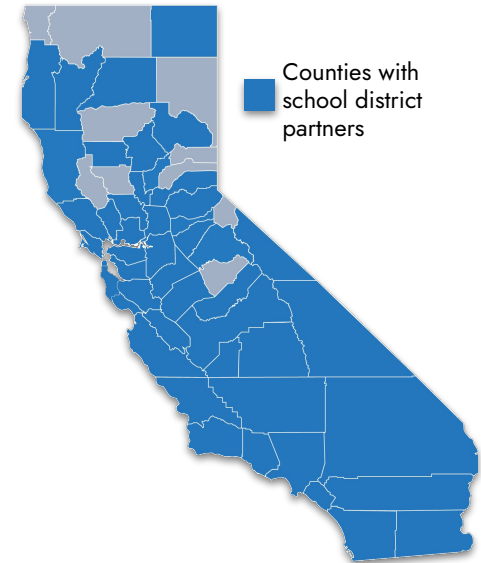

CCGI Partner Districts

More than 70% of California's high school students are enrolled in a school district that has already partnered with CCGI.

- ▶ Our Partner Districts include more than **250 school districts** that serve more than **1.3 million 9th-12th grade students** in California.
- ▶ California Education Code 60900(f)(3) now requires that all LEAs that enroll 9-12 grade students enter into a data sharing agreement with CCGI by **January 2026**.

Partnership With CCGI

Partner Districts have a formal data-sharing agreement (MOU) with CCGI in order to bring their high school transcript data to CaliforniaColleges.edu.

Students with 'Transcript-Informed Accounts' are provided with:

- ▶ **California Community Colleges (CCC) Tool** which helps students to identify the 5 CCCs closest to their high school and to learn more about program options.
- ▶ **CSU and UC Eligibility Tools** that allow students to see their progress towards meeting the minimum requirements for admission to a CSU and UC.
- ▶ The ability to **import verified transcript data** to their Cal State Apply application and UC Application (new!).

The Course Management Portal

The Course Management Portal (CMP) is where all California districts and/or their schools manage their public-facing “A-G Course List”

- ▶ The approved course list from the CMP is what determines which courses fulfill an A-G subject area for the purpose of CSU and UC admissions processes
- ▶ CaliforniaColleges.edu uses the official CMP course list for each school to **verify the transcript data** shared by the district/LEA from its SIS.
- ▶ This informs:
 - How coursework visualizes for students in the **CSU and UC eligibility tools**
 - How courses **import to the CSU and UC applications**





A-G Alignment Support

CCGI provides technical assistance help to LEAs to ensure that courses indicated as fulfilling A-G requirements match the Course Management Portal.

- ▶ California Education Code 60900(g) requires that LEAs maintain at least a 90% rate of alignment between A-G coursework, as listed in the local SIS, and how those courses are registered in the UC Course Management Portal A-G course list.
- ▶ CCGI has a dedicated Technical Assistance team to support districts in improving their CMP match rate.
- ▶ CaliforniaColleges.edu reporting features help educators identify and resolve issues with their CMP list that may impact eligibility for students:
 - Academic Report: **Which district courses are flagged as A-G but do not match against the CMP?**

Courses That Are Not CMP-Verified

Yellow Course = Requires Review

Courses that surface in Yellow:

- ▶ Have been indicated by your district as an A-G course, but **could not be CMP matched** against a school's official A-G list
- ▶ **ALWAYS** require review!
- ▶ **Will require action !** In the UC application, courses in Yellow must be manually entered if they are to be included in the student's application

What about Dual Enrollment?

- ▶ Dual Enrollment (DE) is a method that students can use to meet A-G requirements, but these courses cannot be verified against the CMP.
- ▶ DE will surface in Yellow as “Requires Review” to indicate to the student that **action is required** in their CSU and UC applications.
- ▶ It is by design that DE courses cannot be imported into the high school coursework section of Cal State Apply and the UC Application:
 - College courses must be entered into the College sections of both applications, which are programmed to recognize one semester of College coursework as fulfilling a full year of A-G.

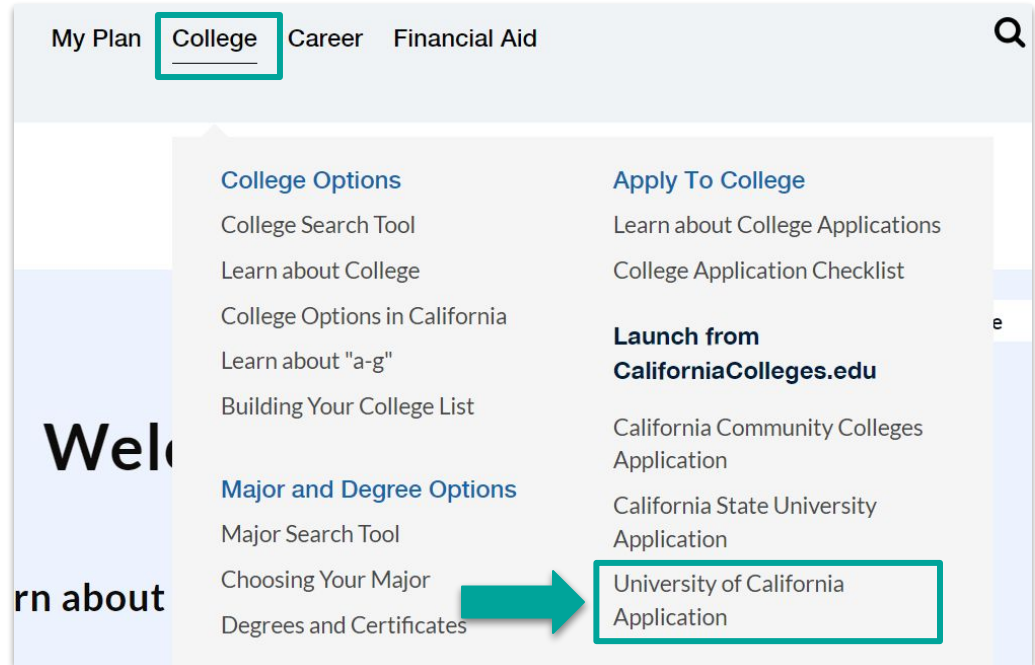

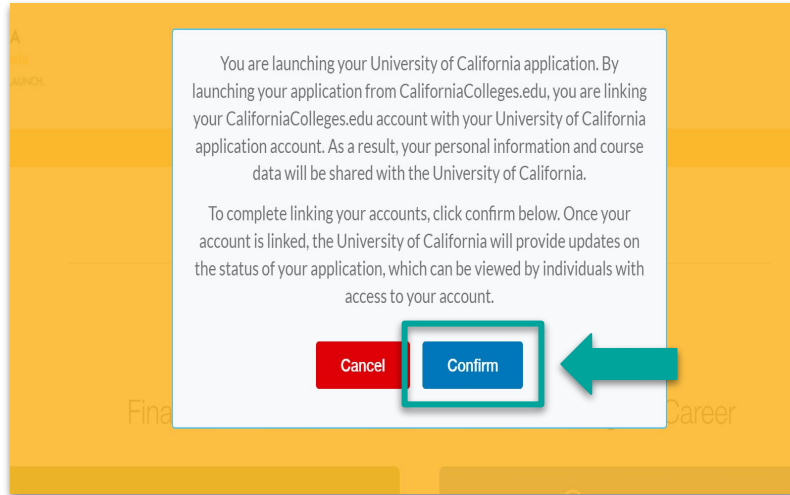

- ▶ Select **University of California Application**.

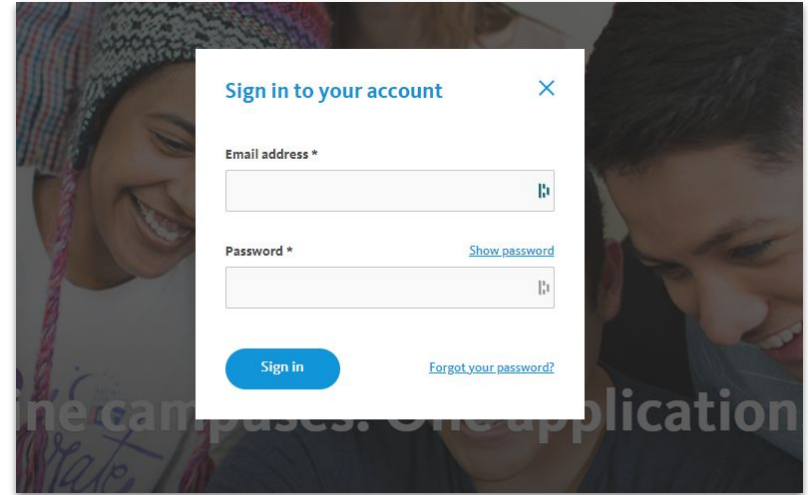




Step 2: Sign In

 - **No.** Students must actively check the box.

 - **Yes,** but import availability may take up to 12 hours

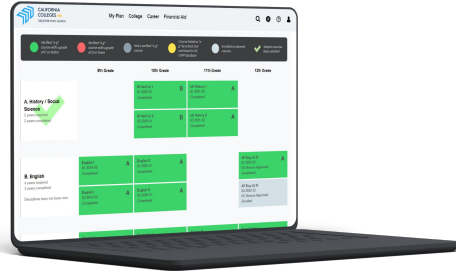


If a student does not select the box initially:

- ▶ Students can select the box at any time.

Courses That (Always) Require Close Review

Whether importing from CaliforniaColleges.edu or not, these types of courses on a transcript require special attention:

- ▶ **Middle School** courses
- ▶ **Dual Enrollment/College** courses
- ▶ Courses completed **outside of California**
- ▶ Courses completed **outside of the US**
- ▶ **Future/Planned Courses**
- ▶ **Summer School Courses**
- ▶ **Repeated Courses**
- ▶ **Credit Recovery with Variable Units**





Review Imported Coursework

- ▶ Prior to application submission, a close review of all application coursework (imported or entered) is important to ensure that it is accurate and complete.
- ▶ All courses in Yellow in the UC Eligibility tools require review
- ▶ Students may need to add or edit courses and grades.

 - Which students have not applied to any segment?
 - Which students have applied to a specific campus?

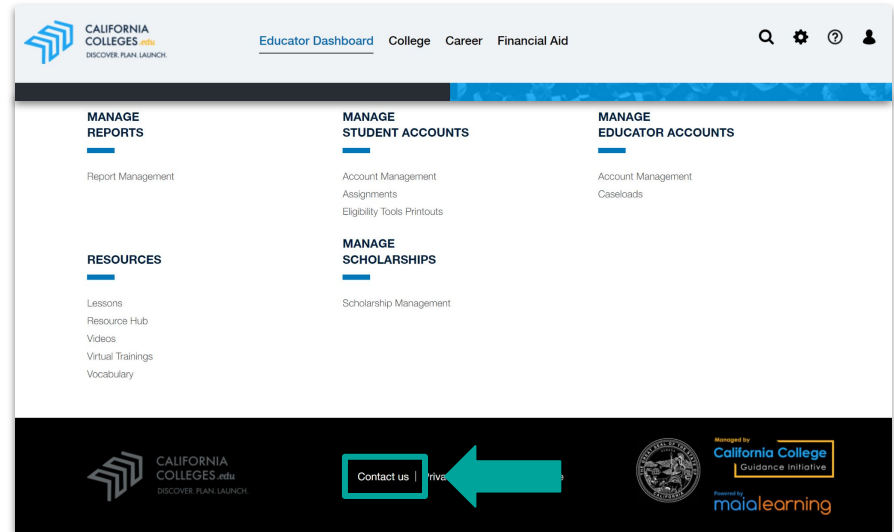
